THE MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL (SCHOOL STREETS) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)  
(VARIATION NO 1) ORDER 2023 - TO/R5.3.86

The Midlothian Council in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to 2(3) and 4(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as "The Midlothian Council (School Streets) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Variation No 1) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the Sixth day of March Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Midlothian Council (School Streets) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 2017 shall have effect as if:

in Article 8(h) all the words deleted and there were inserted the words:

“8(h) to enable the vehicle to enter or leave the Lasswade Primary School Staff Car Park off Pendreich Drive if the driver presents a Midlothian Council Identity Badge when so requested by a Police Constable in uniform.

8(i) for such other purposes as the Council may agree. “.
