MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTIONS ORDER 2023 POLTONHALL & BONNYRIGG GALA DAY PARADE

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force at 11.00am on Sunday 4th June 2023 and is expected to remain in effect until 1.00pm. However once the participants of the event have passed through the road restrictions, the roads will be re-opened. The restriction is required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Poltonhall & Bonnyrigg Gala Day parade.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any vehicle along:

- (a) Cameron Crescent (including bus terminus), from bus terminus to Polton Road West
- (b) Polton Road West, junction Cameron Crescent to junction Polton Avenue Road
- (c) **Polton Avenue Road**, junction Polton Road West to entrance to car park of Poltonhall Recreation Ground.

The roads are being restricted for road safety reasons.

The road closures will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these road closures.
