

MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2024
PENICUIK HARRIERS 10km ROAD RACE

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, which has an anticipated maximum duration of 2 hours, will come into force at 11.00am on Saturday 11th May 2024 and is expected to remain in effect until 1.00pm. However once the participants of the event have passed through the road restrictions, the roads will be re-opened. The restriction is required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Penicuik Harriers 10km Road Race.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any vehicle along:

- (a) **B6372 Bog Road North, Penicuik**
- (b) **B6372 Bog Road South, Penicuik**
- (c) **B6372 West Street, Penicuik**
- (d) **A701 Bridge Street**, junction of West Street to junction of B6372 Pomathorn Road
- (e) **B6372 Pomathorn Road**, junction A701 Bridge Street to junction B7026 Auchendinny Road
- (f) **B7026 Auchendinny Road**, junction of B6372 Pomathorn Road to junction A6094 Howgate
- (g) **Tipperwell Way, Howgate**
- (h) **A6094 Howgate Road**, junction B7026 Auchendinny Road to junction U73 Venture Fair Road
- (i) **U73 Venture Fair Road**, junction A6094 Howgate Road to A701 Peebles Road
- (j) **A701 Peebles Road/Bridge Street**, junction of U73 Venture Fair Road to junction Cairnbank Road
- (k) **Cairnbank Road, Penicuik**
- (l) **Broomhill Road, Penicuik**

The roads are being restricted for road safety reasons.

The road restrictions will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these road closures.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.
