

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force at 7.30am on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2024 and is expected to remain in effect until 1.30pm. However once the participants of the event have passed through the restrictions, the roads will be reopened. The restrictions are required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Penicuik Hunter & Lass Ride Out. When the Order comes into effect no person shall drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any vehicle along:

- (c) Deanburn
- (d) Carnethy Avenue
- (e) Watson Street
- (f) A701 Edinburgh Road
- (g) A701 John Street
- (h) A701 St Kentigern Way
- (i) Jackson Street
- (j) Wilson Street
- (k) A701 High Street
- (I) B6372 West Street
- (m) Broomhill Road
- (n) C59 Harlaw Muir Road
- (o) A701 from Peebles Road to Leadburn
- (p) A6094 Howgate
- (q) B6372: A6094 to U72
- (r) A6094 Howgate to Rosewell
- (s) B7026 Auchendinny Road
- (t) Harper's Brae
- (u) Eskmill Road

The roads are being closed for road safety reasons.

The road closures will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

Alternative route signing will be provided during these road closures.
