(Temporary Closure) Order 2017**

The North Ayrshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order :-

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE- MILL CRESCENT, IRVINE**

1. Mill Crescent, Irvine, from its junction with Mill Road – entire length from **08:00 hours 6<sup>th</sup> February to 18:00 hours 24<sup>th</sup> February 2017** and will remain in operation until the works are completed whichever is the earlier.
  
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on Water Mains works), by reason of works to be executed on or near the public road.

**ALTERNATIVE ROUTES**

No Diversion route required  
Access to Emergency Services will be maintained throughout the closure.

**ORDER**

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

It is considered necessary to make the above Order due to Water Mains works.

**EXTENT AND DURATION**

Mill Crescent, Irvine from its junction with Mill Road –Entire Length is to be closed to traffic under the terms of Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act, 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act, 1991. Restriction to be in duration **from 6<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> February 2017** or until works are complete, whichever is the earlier. Access to emergency vehicles will be permitted.

**EFFECT**

The Order will apply to the specified roads at the above times as indicated by appropriate traffic signs, cones or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform and the effect will be to impose temporary restrictions on use.
