

**The North Ayrshire Council
(B896, Millport, Isle of Cumbrae)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018**

The North Ayrshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order :-

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

1. B896, Millport from a point near Skate Bay to the Caravan Park near Doughend Hole.
2. The Order will come into operation on Monday 3rd December 2018 until Friday 14th December 2018 or until such date as the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. Working hours from 09:15 hours to 20:00 hours each day.
3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of emergency vehicles, residents within this section of B896 and contractual vehicles (carrying out the works) on the road(s) described at paragraph 1. above during the period specified at paragraph 2 above, by reason of works to be executed on or near the public road.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

It is considered necessary to make the above Order due to Cable Installation works within this section of B896, Millport, Isle of Cumbrae, North Ayrshire.

EXTENT AND DURATION

The road(s) described within paragraph 1 are to be closed to traffic under the terms of Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act, 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 as scheduled within paragraph 2.

EFFECT
