**PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (ALYTH TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)
(VARIATION) (NO 1) ORDER 2019
(08/19)**

Perth and Kinross Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1 This Order may be cited as the "Perth and Kinross Council (Alyth Traffic Management) (Variation) (No 1) Order 2019" and shall come into operation on the Twenty-third day of January Two thousand and nineteen.
- 2 The Schedule to the Perth and Kinross Council (Alyth Traffic Management) Order 1998 is hereby varied and shall henceforth have effect subject to the amendments thereto specified and described in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

The Perth and Kinross Council (Alyth Traffic Management) Order 1998 requires to be varied as follows:-

1. At **PART I, GENERAL PROVISIONS, Interpretation** delete the word "Tayside" where it occurs in the definition of "**Chief Constable**" and insert "Police Scotland".
2. At **PART I, GENERAL PROVISIONS, Interpretation** delete the sections "**disabled person**", "**disabled person's badge**" and "**disabled person's vehicle**" in their entirety and insert the following:-

"**disabled person**" means a disabled person of a description prescribed by Regulation 4 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"**disabled persons' badge**" has the meaning assigned to it by Regulation 11 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"**disabled persons' vehicle**" means a motor vehicle which is displaying a disabled persons badge being used in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;"

The Schedule to the Perth and Kinross Council (Alyth Traffic Management) Order 1998 requires to be varied as follows:-

1. At **PART I ONE WAY STREETS**, at Columns 1 and 2 insert the following:-

"MARKET SQUARE (CENTRE)
between its junction with Airlie Street
and Market Square (northeast leg)
or thereby.

Northeastwards, that is to say from
Airlie Street towards Market Square
(northeast leg).

MARKET SQUARE (NORTHWEST LEG)
between its junction with the Airlie Street
and Market Square (northeast leg)
or thereby."

Northeastwards, that is to say from
Airlie Street towards Market Square
(northeast leg).

Council Reasons

Due to the refurbishment and environmental improvements at Market Square, Alyth the Council wish to introduce additional one way road restrictions on the northwest leg of Market Square and the newly constructed road through the centre of Market Square. These restrictions will allow the new layout of Market Square to flow as intended and improve safety for pedestrians and all road users.

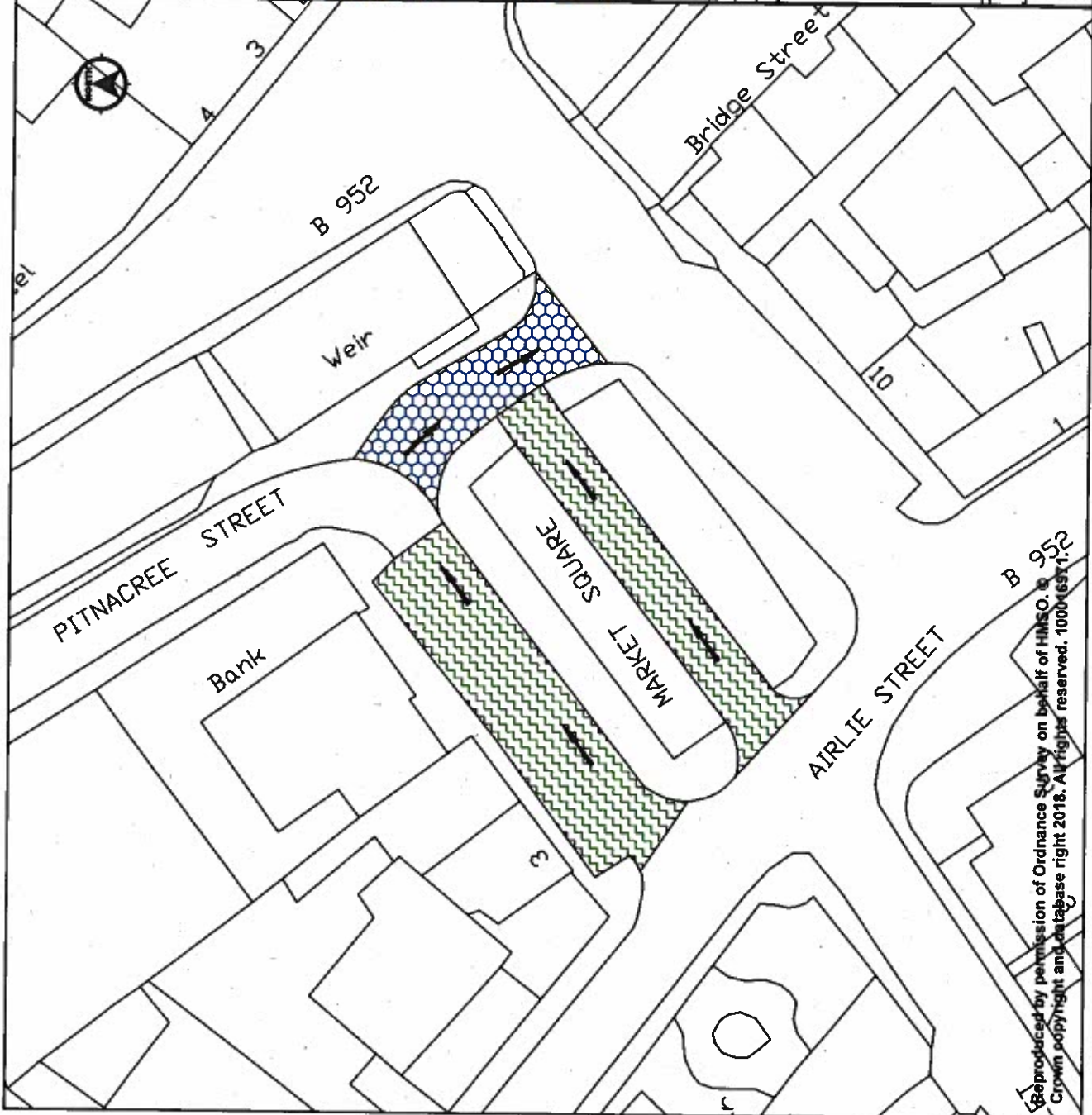
