The Renfrewshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1 Citation and Commencement

- (a) This Order may be cited as "The Renfrewshire Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Various Locations, Renfrewshire) Number Six Order 20**" and shall come into operation on the XX day of XX Two Thousand and XX.

2 Interpretation

- (a) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"building line " means the line forming the foremost elevation of a building unless the rear building line is specified;

"carriageway marking" means a traffic sign consisting of a line or legend on a road;

"Chief Constable" means Commander of K Division of Police Scotland;

"Council" means The Renfrewshire Council;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2(1) of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying in the relevant position in terms of regulations for the time being in force under the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 ("the 1970 Act") a disabled person's badge issued in terms of such regulations by a local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the 1970 Act;

"duprn" means disabled unique property reference numbers.

"emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used by the Police, Fire and Rescue Service or Ambulance Services;

"extended kerbline" means a projection of the existing kerbline taken to a point at which it intersects with a projection of the existing kerbline of another carriageway with which it abuts. Where the kerblines are curved at any corner, the point of intersection of those kerblines shall be regarded as the point on the curve nearest to the point at which those kerblines, if extended in straight lines from each end of the curve, would meet;

"extended line" means a projection of the line of a said object to its intersection with the kerbline of a road;

"gable" means the wall forming one of the sides of a building;

"kerb" means the edging to a carriageway;

"parking place" means such a part of the carriageway that is allocated for use of the temporarily leaving of a vehicle.

"plan" means the map entitled "This is the plan referred to in the foregoing The Renfrewshire Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Various Locations, Renfrewshire) Number Three Order 2016, which map for the avoidance of doubt forms part of this Order;

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power.

Please note;

- (a) All words importing the singular also include the plural and vice versa where the context requires.
- (b) Except where the context otherwise requires, references to any enactment include any such enactment as amended, extended or applied by or under any other enactment.
- (c) All signs and carriageway and kerb markings shall comply with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

3 Disabled Persons' Vehicle Parking Place

- (a) The area of road shown coloured red, blue or green and identified by a DUPRN number in this Order is authorised for use as such a parking place as may only be used by a disabled person's vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and that in accordance with the following provisions:-
- (b) The limits of the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall be indicated on the carriageway in such a manner as the Council may determine by signs, carriageway markings, lines or other indications.
- (c) Every vehicle left in a parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall so stand that no parking bay is occupied by more than one vehicle and that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking bay provided that where the length of the vehicle precludes compliance with this paragraph, such vehicle shall be deemed to be within the limits of a parking place if:-
 - (i) the extreme front portion or, as the case may be, the extreme rear portion of the vehicle is within 300mm of an indication on the carriageway provided under this Article in relation to the parking place; and
 - (ii) the vehicle, or any part thereof, is not within the limits of any adjoining parking place.
- (d) Any person duly authorised by the Council or a Police Constable in uniform or parking attendant may move or cause to be moved in case of emergency, to any place he or she thinks fit, any vehicle left in a parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- (e) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of the parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this Order or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary:-
 - (i) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (ii) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition, or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe, apparatus for the supply of gas, water or

electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus, traffic sign or parking ticket machine.

- (iii) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another office or dwelling house or the removal of furniture from such office or dwelling house to a depository or to such office or dwelling house from a depository;
 - (iv) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - (v) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions.
- (f) A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a parking place or part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.

4 Disabled Persons' Parking Places to be Consolidated

- (a) The Disabled Persons' Parking Places in "The Renfrewshire Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Various Locations, Renfrewshire) Number Five Order 2018" specified in schedule 1 to this Order, shown coloured blue and identified with a DUPRN number shall be consolidated within this Order and shall have effect subject to this order.

5 New Disabled Persons' Parking Places

- (a) The Disabled Persons' Parking Places specified in schedule 1 to this Order, shown coloured red and identified with a DUPRN number are new regulatory bays.

6 Disabled Persons' Parking Places to be Amended

- (a) The Disabled Persons' Parking Places in "The Renfrewshire Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Various Locations, Renfrewshire) Number Five Order 2018" referenced in schedule 1 to this Order, shown coloured green and identified with a DUPRN number shall be amended to comply with Article 2.(c) of this Order.

7 Disabled Persons' Parking Places to be Removed

- (a) The Disabled Persons' Parking Places specified in schedule 1 to this Order, shown coloured grey and identified with a DUPRN number shall be removed.

8 Orders to be Revoked

- (a) The Order specified in schedule 2 to this Order shall be revoked.
