



**(C2 Belston-Woodside-Stair Road (Bridge of Coyle) nr. Coylton)  
(18 Tonne Weight Restriction) Order 2022**

**NOTICE OF MAKING**

Notice is hereby given that on 28 April 2022 the Council made the above named Order under the terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers.

The Order which comes into force on Thursday 5 May 2022 was advertised in the Ayrshire Post on 2 June 2021 and the effect of the Order is as stated in said notice that being to introduce a weight restriction on the following length of road to protect the structure of the bridge that runs over the River Coyle with statutory exemptions including emergency services vehicles.

**18 Tonne Weight Restriction**

**C2/C10 Bridge of Coyle:** from a point 5 metres east to a point 5 metres west of the bridge deck.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 1984 Act), or on the grounds that any requirement of the Acts, or of any other instrument made under the 1984 Act, has not been complied with in relation to this Order may, within six weeks from 28 April 2022 apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
