Scottish Natural Heritage (SNH) declares that the area of ground extending to 598.08 hectares or thereby and shown within the red line on the attached map, which is the land referred to in the Monach Isles National Nature Reserve no.2 declaration 2004 is no longer being managed as a nature reserve*.

Therefore, with effect from 18 May 2018, the Declaration referred to above is withdrawn.

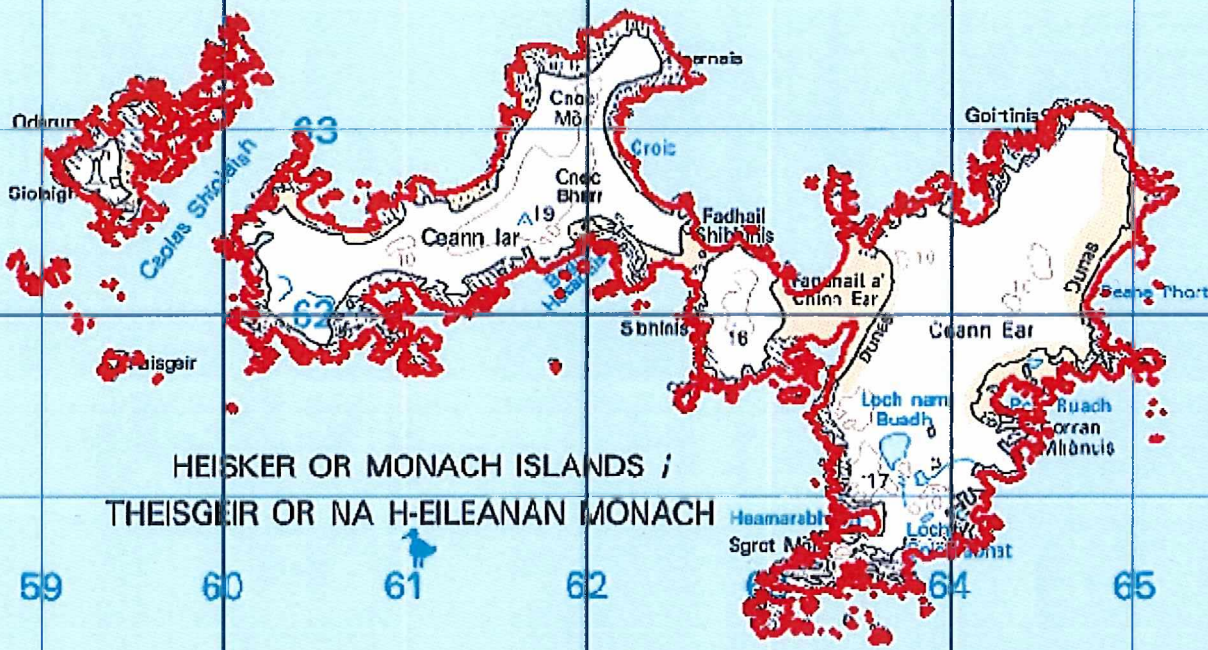

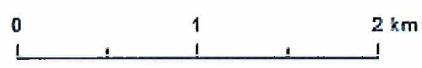
