DE-DECLARATION 2018**

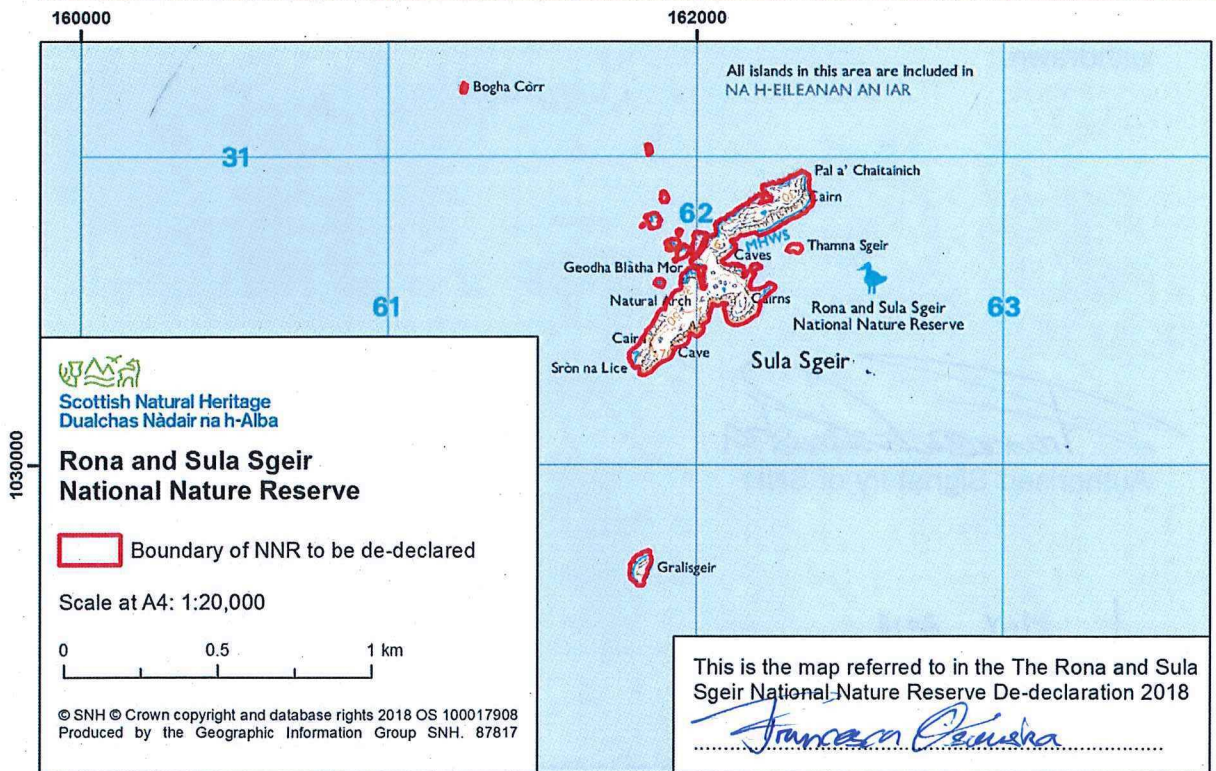
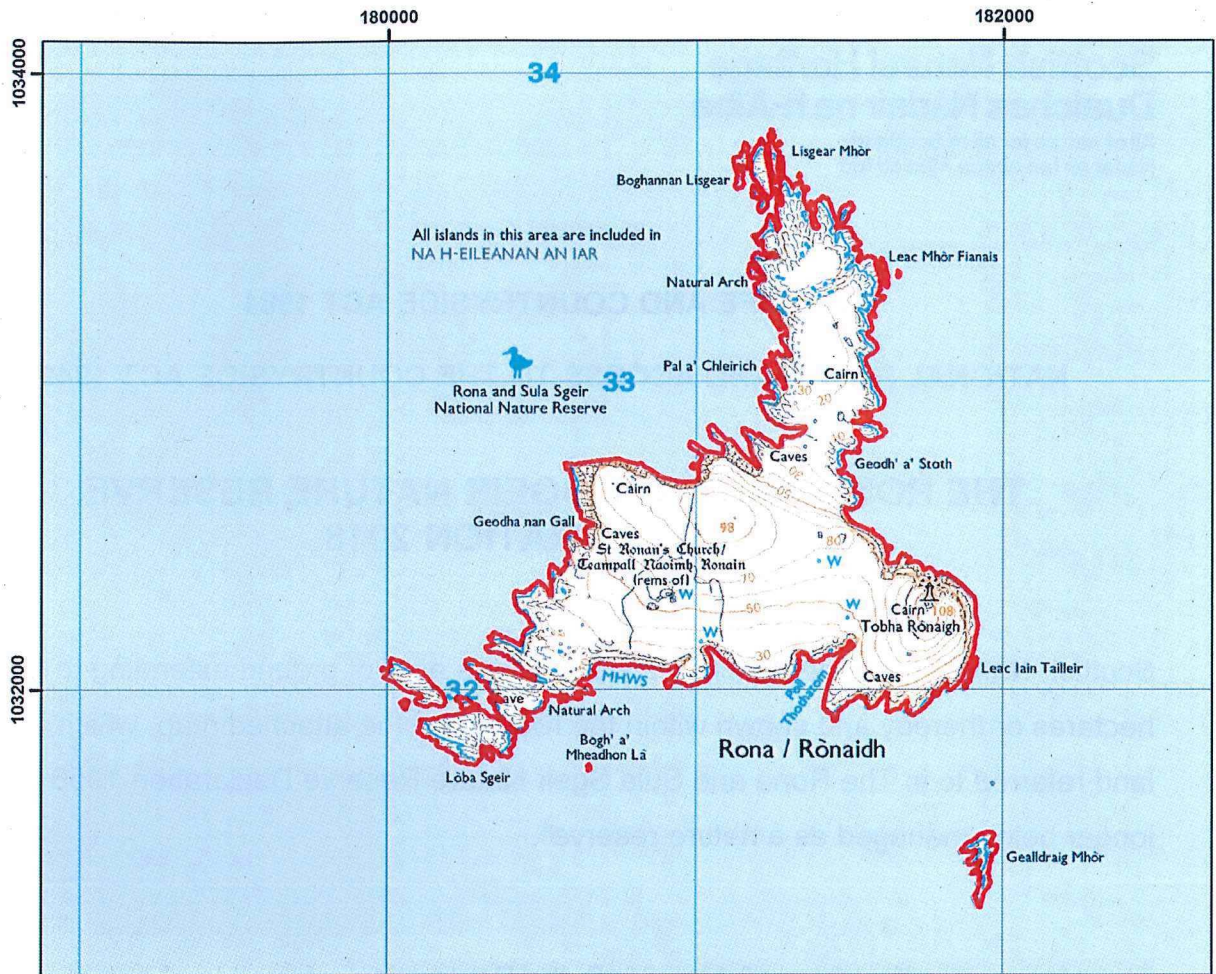
Scottish Natural Heritage (SNH) declares that the area of ground extending to 138.8 hectares or thereby and shown within the red line on the attached map, which is the land referred to in The Rona and Sula Sgeir Nature Reserve Declaration 1956 is no longer being managed as a nature reserve*.

Therefore, with effect from 18 May 2018, the Declaration referred to above is withdrawn.

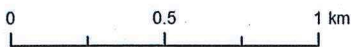
