This letter is to inform you that we have denotified part of St Margaret's Marsh Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI). The area denotified is shown on the enclosed map. The remainder of the SSSI is unaffected and I enclose a copy of the revised map.

We made this decision as this area no longer contains the features of special interest, which were lost following the construction of the B981 as part of the infrastructure network supporting the Queensferry Crossing.

The denotification of this part of St Margaret's Marsh SSSI takes effect from the date of this letter.

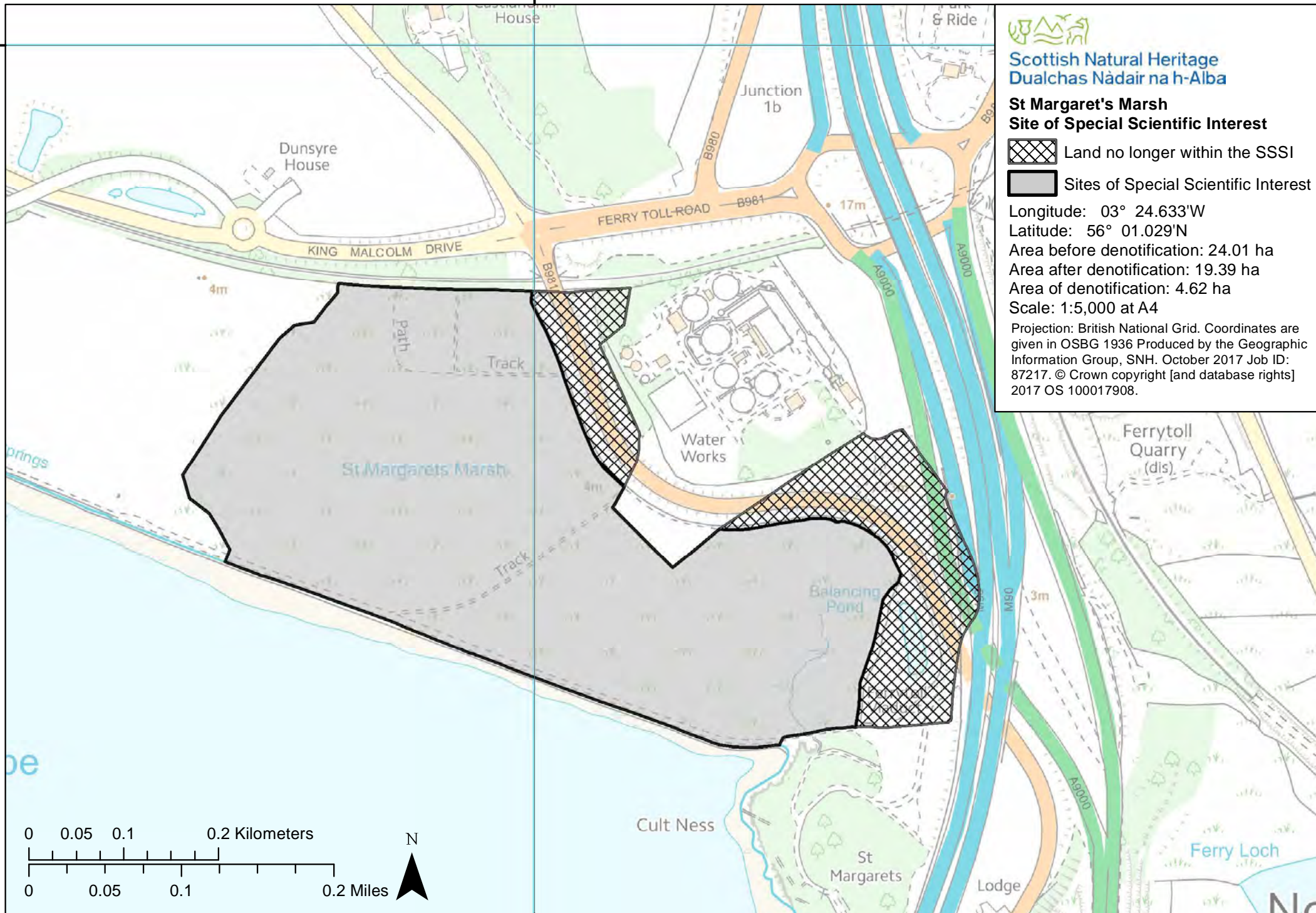
